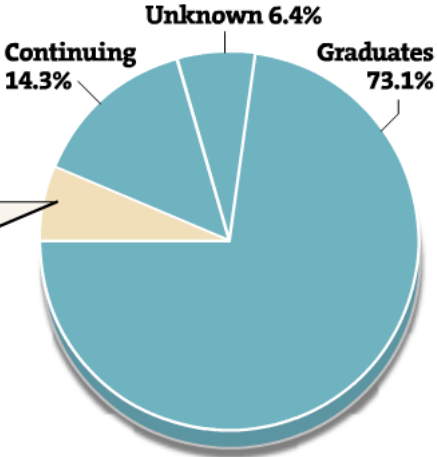
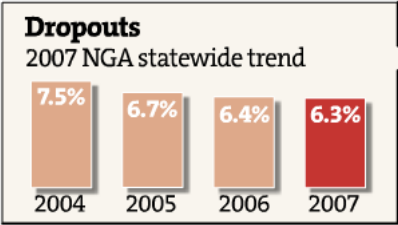
Seniors' Interest in School is Waning

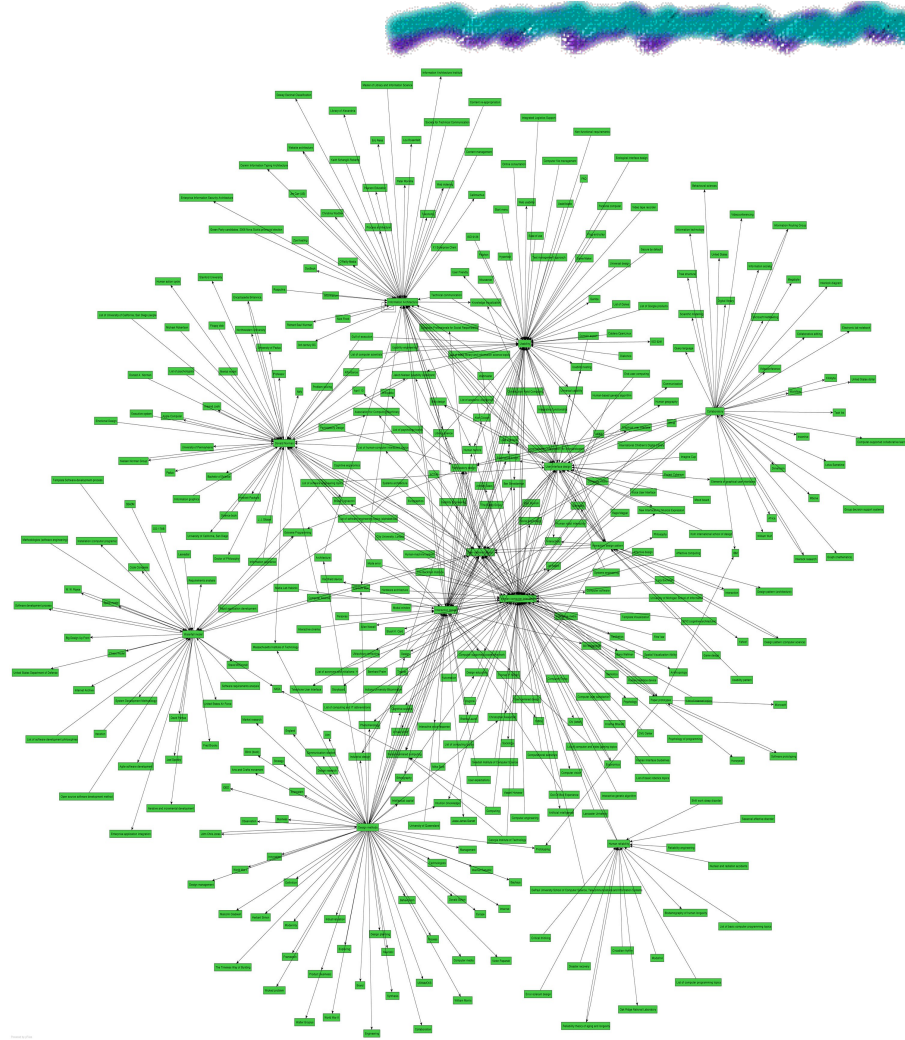

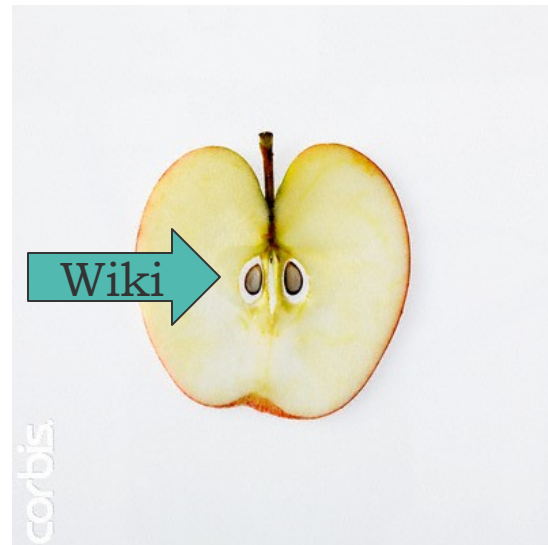

Missouri Circuit Court of St. Louis County



1st Trial(1847)-
Dred Scott sued for freedom—but was declined

2nd Trial(1850)-
Court ruled that the Scott's deserve to be free based on their years of residence in non slave territories

1852-
Reversed the decision of the Circuit Court saying the Scotts were NOT free



Missouri Supreme Court



Supreme Court of the U.S.

1857-
Declared that Scott should remain a slave.
As a slave he is not a citizen of the U.S., therefore not allowed to have his case heard.
As a slave he is personal property and has never been free.

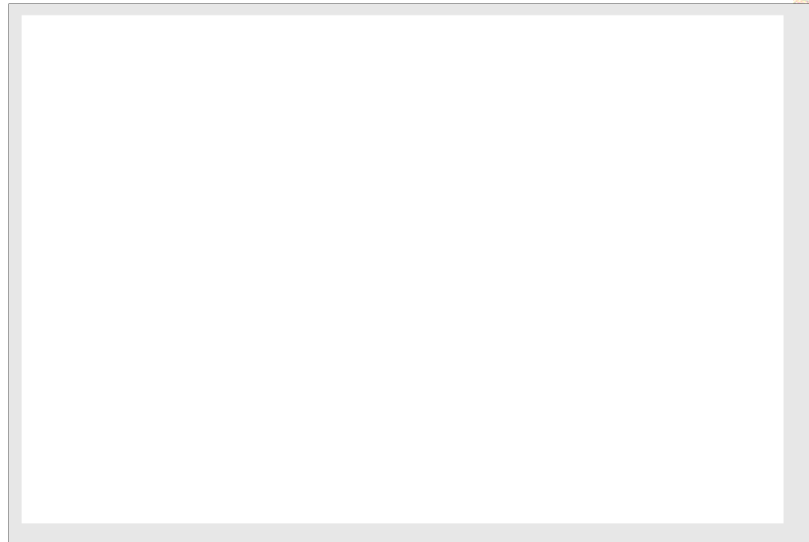
